The 2nd International Iran Javan Photo Festival Photography Contest: "The Image of the Iranian Youth"

The Public Relations and Information Center of the Ministry of Health and Medical Education, with the central role of Torbat Heydarieh University of Medical Sciences and in collaboration with the Tasvir Sal Iranian Cultural and Artistic Institute, is organizing the 2nd International "Iran Javan" Photo Festival featuring the photo competition "The Image of the Iranian Youth."

This event highlights the characteristics and future-shaping roles of Iranian youth within the family and society, as seen through the lens of photographers, and will be held in four categories with the following themes:

- Category I: The Image of the Iranian Youth (Photography with Camera)
- Category II: The Image of the Iranian Youth (Mobile Photography)
- International Category: The Young World The Role of Youth in Shaping the Future of the World (Photography with Camera and Mobile)

Showcasing the active participation of young people from different countries in building the future of the world across social, economic, cultural, and other spheres

• **Special Category**: Saffron – The Warmth of Iranian Families (Photography with Camera and Mobile)

This section introduces saffron as one of the most significant and symbolic products of the Torbat Heydarieh region and highlights its impact on family life.

Photographers are invited to capture images portraying the cultivation, harvesting, and processing of saffron, as well as its role in the livelihood of households and the local culture in saffron-producing regions across Iran.

The goal of this category is to promote awareness of saffron's importance in the economic and social life of families and to honor the dedicated efforts of farmers engaged in this valuable field.

Main Competition Themes:

- Captured moments of emotional connections between young people and their families in Iran (parents, siblings, grandparents).
- The presence and role of youth in creating a joyful and hopeful atmosphere in society.
- The role of mothers in nurturing and promoting the health of the young generation.
- Wedding ceremonies in rural and urban areas of Iran.
- National and international achievements of Iranian youth in scientific, artistic, athletic, and other fields.
- The presence and contribution of the young population in shaping the history, civilization, and culture of today's and tomorrow's Iran.

Category I: The Image of the Iranian Youth (Photography with Camera)

Category II: The Image of the Iranian Youth (Mobile Photography)

- 10 Selected Photos: Each awarded 10 million tomans + Certificate of Honor
- 5 Commended Photos: Each awarded 5 million tomans + Letter of Appreciation

International Category: The Young World (Photography with Camera and Mobile)

- 5 Selected Photos: Each awarded 20 million tomans + Certificate of Honor
- 5 Commended Photos: Each awarded 5 million tomans + Letter of Appreciation

Special Category: Saffron – The Warmth of Iranian Families (Photography with Camera and Mobile)

- 5 Selected Photos: Each awarded 20 million tomans + Certificate of Honor
- 5 Commended Photos: Each awarded 5 million tomans + Letter of Appreciation

Special Student Award:

In order to encourage and motivate the participation of students from universities across the country, student submissions will not only compete within the festival's four main categories but will also be entered into a **Special Student Award** section, designed specifically for competition among student works.

- Top 3 Photos: Each awarded 20 million tomans
- Second 3 Photos: Each awarded 10 million tomans
- Next 4 Photos: Each awarded 5 million tomans

Note: For copyright remuneration, each work selected for the exhibition and the photo book will receive **1 million tomans**, in addition to the **Certificate of Participation**.

Submission Requirements:

- A maximum of 7 works can be submitted for each of the main and special categories, in JPG format.
- Minimum length: **70 cm** with a resolution of **150 DPI**.
- Maximum file size: 10 MB.
- Mobile photographs are accepted **only in high quality**.
- Files smaller than **1.5 MB** will **not be accepted**.
- For square-framed photos, a length of **60 cm** is sufficient.
- Works generated with **artificial intelligence** are **not permitted**.
- The **physical and intellectual ownership** of submitted works must belong to the participant; the festival secretariat assumes **no responsibility**.
- Submission of correct participant information is **mandatory**, including:
- Full name in **Persian and English**
- Contact number
- **Email address** (for sending the Certificate of Participation if selected)
- A **brief description of the photo**, submitted as a Word file.
